Stuart Brown is in his 19<sup>th</sup> year of coaching and soccer administration, having coached at the youth, collegiate and professional levels during his career.

Currently, Stuart is in his fifth year as Executive Director of Tennessee Soccer Club (TSC). Alongside his administrative duties, he also coaches the 2004 Girls Elite Clubs National League (ECNL). Prior to his time in Nashville with TSC, Stuart was the Director of U15-U18 Boys with CASL (now North Carolina FC). He coached collegiately for 8 years at Louisburg College and Belmont Abbey College. In 2001 He began his full-time professional soccer pathway working with the Carolina Courage and CASL shortly followed by becoming the Director of Coaching in Charlotte, NC at Gaston United Soccer Club where he remained part of the organization as Director of Coaching and Executive Director for seven years.

Last year in 2017-18, Stuart led the 2003 Boys ECNL team on a fantastic journey of development and success. Under his guidance, the team finished in 1<sup>st</sup> Place in TN State League play and also won the USYS State Cup. In ECNL play, they finished in 2<sup>nd</sup> Place in the South East Conference. The team capped off their wonderful season by winning the Elite National Premier League National Championship in Denver, CO. This was the third consecutive year that a TSC team won a National Championship (2017 and 2016, USYS), all under the leadership of Stuart as Executive Director.

A longtime member of United Soccer Coaches and the NSCAA, Stuart continues to place great value in coaching education and professional development. He currently holds NSCAA Premier Diploma, NSCAA Advanced National Diploma, NSCAA Goalkeeping II Diploma, and his USSF A License.

Stuart has shown a genuine commitment to the youth soccer community in Greater Nashville and throughout the state of Tennessee. His vision has allowed TSC to continue to grow and positively impact its members and the soccer community that it serves.
