

Adrian Parrish, Director of Coaching

Parrish joined Kentucky Youth Soccer in October of 2005 as the associations third full time Director of Coaching. In this role, Parrish is responsible for the Coaching Education Program and the management of the Olympic Development Program. Prior to this appointment, he was the Director of Coaching for Amherst Soccer Association in Buffalo, New York in addition the Head Olympic Development Program Coach and Coaching Education Instructor for New York State West Youth Soccer Association.

In 2000, Parrish moved to the United States where he served as the National Assistant Director of Coaching for Britannia Soccer USA and as the Director of Coaching for Great Falls Soccer Club in the Washington DC Metro area. Prior to moving the United States, Parrish played extensively at the youth level with Boston United (formally English Conference league). After suffering numerous injuries attempting to break through as a player in the professional ranks, Adrian opted to remain in the game by starting his coaching career. One of his first appointments included serving as the Grimsby Town Football Club Youth Development Officer and Assistant Youth Team Coach.

A native of Louth, England, Parish currently possesses a USSF "A" License, UEFA "A" License (Pending), and the US Youth Soccer National Youth License. In addition, Adrian is the Head Women's Coach for the Kentucky Wanderers, on the Region II Boys ODP staff, a USSF Coaching Education and US Youth Soccer National Instructor.
